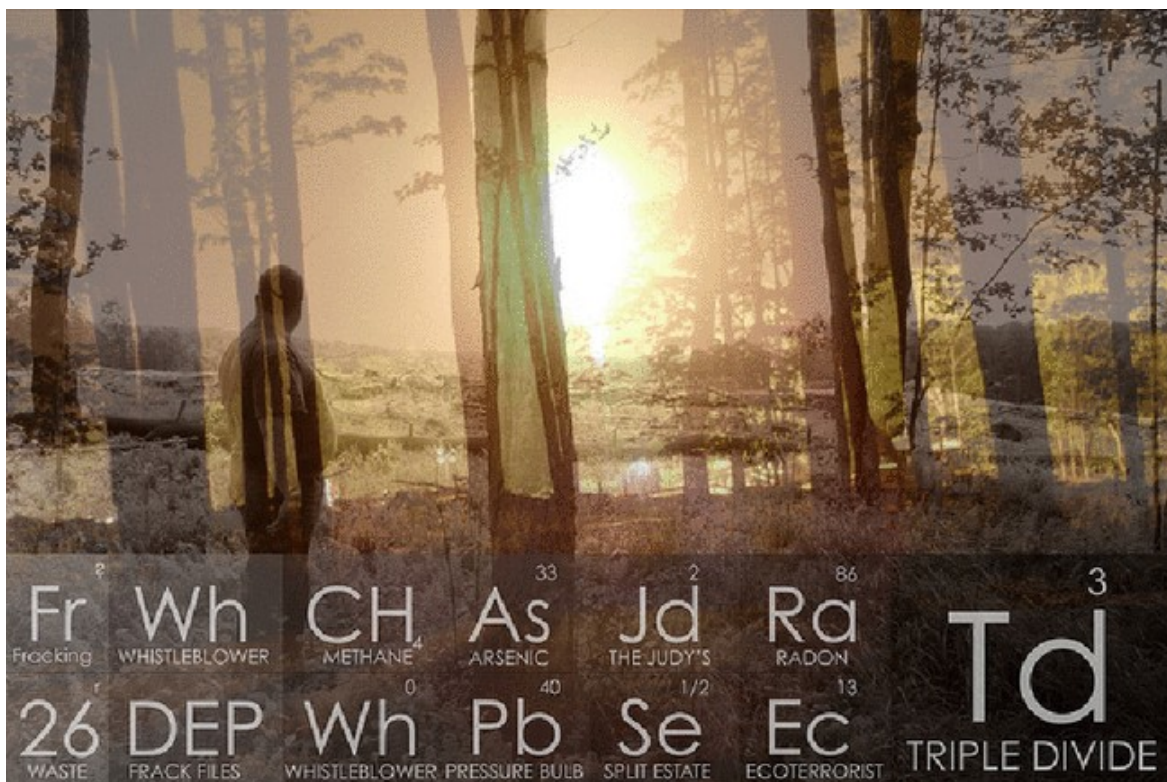


# ***Triple Divide: A New Film About Fracking***
